

Student Legal Settlement Application

Bremen Public Schools

The Indiana legislature modified the student legal settlement statutes. Now, a custodial parent can annually elect a student's legal settlement, which must be either the residence of the custodial parent or non-custodial parent. The election must be made fourteen (14) days before the first student day. This election may be made only on a yearly basis and the student or parent who makes the election may not be charged transfer tuition. The Indiana code does not require the student to live within the elected school corporation boundaries, just one of his or her parents. The following application form must be completed, signed, verifying documents attached, and returned to the principal.
