1. If you are planning to take any summer school courses at BHS, you must complete and return the bottom of this form to the Guidance Office by Friday, March 16, 2012. **ALL FEES MUST BE PAID WHEN YOU TURN IN YOUR FORM, IN ORDER TO FINALIZE A SEAT IN THE CLASS.**
2. If the minimum course enrollment of 15 students is not reached by Friday, March 16, 2012, the course may be cancelled. Once the maximum enrollment has been reached, all applicants will be informed of their enrollment status. Your money will be refunded if we do not have the class or if the course size has to be cut. If you drop the summer school class for any other reason, your money will not be refunded.
3. All course offerings are contingent upon approval by the School Board in addition to the availability of adequate funding sources and course enrollment totals. We are hoping to be able to finalize the summer school class rosters and confirm course offerings by April 16th.
4. According to Board Policy, students must be present 90% of the course in order to receive course credit; therefore, students who are enrolled in a 4-week (4 hr./day) summer school course can miss no more than two days (8 hours) of instruction.
